

RII40715 Certificate IV in Civil Construction Supervision

COURSE DESCRIPTION



Immediate start

This qualification reflects the role of employees working in supervisory positions in civil construction. They are responsible for the quantity and quality of the output of others, contribute to the development of technical solutions to non-routine problems and apply management plans to the workplace.

The qualification consists of five (5) core and seven (7) elective units and can include the *Conduct Road Safety* course regularly conducted by IPWEA. This course facilitates registration as a road safety auditor.

BSBMGT401 - Show leadership in the workplace

BSBMGT402 - Implement operational plan

BSBWHS401 - Implement and monitor WHS policies, procedures and programs to meet legislative requirements

RIICWM401D - Supervise civil works

RIIRIS401D - Apply site risk management system

Elective Units

RIIWH302D - Implement traffic management plan

RSACRA001 - Conduct road safety audits

BSBPMG522 - Undertake project work

RIICSG405D - Carry out inspections of civil structures

RIICSG406D - Apply principles of maintenance of civil structures

Two additional electives to be chosen on enrolment that apply to the candidate's work environment. Discuss with IPWEA staff on enrolment.



COURSE DURATION



Candidates are expected to compete within twelve (12) to eighteen (18) months but additional time can be allocated under extenuating circumstances.

Candidates should allocate up to 3 hours per week to do Recognition knowledge activities and collect evidence.

Workshops will be conducted on a monthly basis in a combination of online and face-to-face workshops.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS



There are no formal entry requirements for this qualification.

Candidates will need to be working in a civil construction environment to demonstrate application of skills. They will also need to demonstrate sound oral and written communication in English and Numeracy.

A computer with internet access is also required and ability to operate Word and Excel programs.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS



Candidates are required to undertake phone or online interviews with IPWEA trainers and assessors to verify evidence and support progress. An initial interview is mandatory to explain the Recognition process and finalise elective choice.

FEES AND PAYMENTS



Course Introductory prices are \$4,500.00.

\$2,500.00 will be payable on commencement and \$2,000.00 is payable three (3) months after commencement.
